

Triennial Assessment of Local Wellness Policy from June 24th, 2026

The Local Wellness Policy Triennial Assessment was completed to evaluate compliance with State and USDA requirements.

Summary of Results

The Local Wellness Policy was reviewed on 06/24/26, results as follows:

- Reviewed and chose Goals for the upcoming 2026-2027 school year -
 1. More homemade foods – breakfast & lunch (following USDA meal pattern)
 2. Increase fruit selection at lunch
 3. Provide one nutrition education activity each semester
 4. Daily recess
 5. Hold wellness committee meeting more frequently and/or join the Students Advisory Board meeting to get more involvement in the Local Wellness Policy
 6. Share one wellness update with families each semester
- Monitoring each goal to determine success
 1. Menus, menu planning,
 2. Monthly observation, student surveys
 3. Teacher lesson plans
 4. School daily schedule
 5. Meeting flyers, agendas & sign – in sheets, attend Student Advisory Meetings
 6. Use Skyward messages, social media posts, flyers, bulletin boards,
- Improvement needed with stakeholders, including school administrators, food service staff, teachers, parents, students, school board members, and community representatives, were provided opportunities to participate in the assessment process.
- Improve on Frequency of Local Wellness Policy Meetings
- Strengths - Good job at following the compliance with USDA meal pattern requirements & Smart Snack, offer more vegetables on vegetable bar for students
- Planned first meeting of School Year for October 21st, 2026 – tentatively, more information will follow once school starts

CLK has made satisfactory progress toward achieving the goals outlined in the Local Wellness Policy. School meal programs remain in compliance with federal nutrition standards, and wellness initiatives continue to support student health and academic success. The Wellness Committee will continue to stay involved through ongoing evaluation, stakeholder engagement, and continuous improvement.
