Also present were Christopher Davidson, Superintendent; Trevor Salata, Chief Financial Officer and Elsa Green, Executive Administrative Assistant to the Superintendent.

On motion, seconded (Wickstrom-Parker) unanimous decision, minutes from previous meetings were approved.

On motion, seconded (Vertin-Wickstrom) unanimous decision, the bills were approved to be paid. The General Fund bills were \$296,926.93, Athletic bills were \$26,182.72, Cafeteria bills were \$205.13, Community Service bills were \$4,846.29, for a total of all invoices of \$328,161.07.

The Treasurer's report was accepted as read on motion, seconded (Wickstrom-Campioni) unanimous decision. The General Fund showed a bank balance of \$752,092.05, plus a Money Market of \$4,784,115.09, less outstanding checks of (\$61,155.33), less a Transfer in Transit (ORS) of (\$104,386.52), for a total General Fund balance as of July 31, 2022, of \$5,370,665.29.

The Athletic Account showed a bank balance as of July 31, 2022, of \$50,333.35, for a total Athletic Fund of \$50,333.35.

The Cafeteria Fund showed a balance of \$31,215.51, for a total School Service Fund balance of \$81,548.86.
