The Board of Education of the Public Schools of Calumet, Laurium and Keweenaw held its regular monthly meeting on October 8, 2019, at 5:30 p.m., in the Board of Education Room.

On motion, seconded (Wickstrom-Vertin) unanimous decision, minutes from previous meetings were approved.

On motion, seconded (Parker-Vertin) unanimous decision, the bills were approved to be paid. The General Fund bills were \$114,334.73, Athletic bills were \$18,270.89, Cafeteria bills were \$21,724.57, Community Service bills were \$150.05 for a total of all invoices of \$154,480.24.

The Treasurer's report was accepted as read on motion, seconded (Vertin-Wickstrom) unanimous decision. The General Fund showed a bank balance of \$625,292.78, plus a Money Market of \$1,225,929.21, less outstanding checks of (\$64,642.85), less a Transfer in Transit (ORS) of (\$99,303.06), plus a Transfer in Transit (Cafeteria Fund) of \$9,381.13, plus a Transfer in Transit (Debt Service) Fund of \$40.43, plus a Transfer in Transit (Athletic Fund) of \$19,300.00 for a total General Fund balance as of September 30, 2019, of \$1,715,997.64.

The Athletic Account showed a bank balance as of September 30, 2019, of \$45,280.39, less a Transfer in Transit of (\$19,300.00) for a total Athletic Fund of \$25,980.39.

The Cafeteria Fund showed a balance of \$42,128.94, less a Transfer in Transit of (\$9,381.13) for a total School Service Fund balance of \$58,728.20.

The 1995 Bond Debt Retirement Fund showed a bank balance of \$1,254,404.07, less a Transfer in transit General Fund of (40.43) for a total 1995 Debt Retirement Fund balance as of September 30, 2019, of \$1,254,363.64.

Mr. Ed Jenich presented a check to the Board of Education from the Keweenaw Health Foundation.

On motion, seconded (Zubiena-Campioni) unanimous decision, the Board of Education expressed their appreciation to the Keweenaw Health Foundation for their generous donation to support the health of CLK students and staff.

On motion, seconded (Parker-Vertin) unanimous decision, the Board of Education authorized a contract with Great Lakes Recovery Center providing employee's access to an Employee Assistance Program. The school district further agrees to an expenditure of \$16.00/employee (125) or \$2,000.00 as the district's participating cost.
