Breakfast is served every day for free from 7:30 a.m. - 8:30 a.m. Low-sugar, whole grain cereal, apple or iced cinnamon oatmeal bars, pancakes, waffles, or french toast are some of the items offered at breakfast. All breakfast comes with fresh fruit, 100% fruit juice and fat free or 1% white milk.

A Few Reminders

- Please park your car in the roped off area when visiting the school. When you enter the building, please sign in and out on the computer in the entranceway at Ms. Laura's window.
- If your son or daughter will be absent from school, please give us a call first thing in the morning, 337-0311 option 1, option 1 for attendance, or email Laura at lmattila@clkschools.org.
- Instruction begins at 8:30 a.m. and children begin getting ready to go home at 3:12 p.m. Dismissal is staggered times starting with grade 5. Busses leave the school at approximately 3:23 p.m.
- If you are picking your child up after school, please go through the public library doors, turn left and pick them up from the HS/MS cafeteria.
- If you are picking your child up from school before regular dismissal, please park your car in the roped off area and sign your child out on the computer in the entrance of the elementary. Ms. Laura or Ms. Kara will call your child to the entrance to meet you.

Change of Plans, Bus Passes and Notes at the End of the Day

- Bus passes are for day care purposes only.
- Discuss after school plans with your child ahead of time.
- Send a note to the teacher with any change in plans.
- If you must change route #'s please send a note for a bus pass along with the student's first and last name, whose house with address, teacher's name and route number where they are going. Please call before 2:00 p.m. when your plans have changed. Thank you!

Health Concerns of Your Child

If your child has any type of health concern, mild or severe, please let the school nurse know. We need details of your health concern as well as the reaction i.e. allergy to amoxicillin = upset stomach, nausea/diarrhea or allergy to kiwi = throat and lips swell, etc. The type of reaction to the food, medicine, allergen or health condition is very important. If you need to have a doctor send information to us, please let us know. Also if your child has any type of asthma, mild or severe, and has a prescription for an inhaler, you will need to fill out the medication forms.

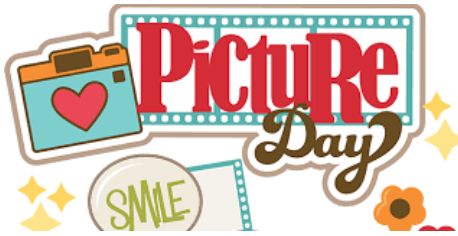
SAFETY FIRST
