What Is Title I?

Title I is a federally funded program that provides funding to states and school districts to help meet the needs of educationally at-risk students. The goal of Title I is to provide extra instructional



services beyond the regular classroom to students who are performing below grade level expectations and are most at risk of failing the state's challenging performance standards in mathematics, reading, and writing. Support is provided by a Title I teacher or paraprofessional either individually, or in a small group. Students are selected for services based on specific assessments, student progress and teacher observation.

•If you are picking your child up from school before regular dismissal, please park your car in the visitor area and sign your child out on the computer in the entrance of the elementary school. Ms. Laura or Ms. Kara will call your child to the entrance to meet you.

Change of Plans, Bus Passes and Notes at the End of the Day

*Discuss after school plans with your child ahead of time.

*Send a note to the teacher with any change in plans.

*If you must change route #'s please send a note for a bus pass along with the student's first and last name, whose house with address, teacher's name and route number where they are going. Please call before 2:00 p.m. when your plans have changed. Thank you!

Health Concerns of Your Child

If your child has any type of health concern, mild or severe, please let the school nurse know. We need details of your health concern as well as the reaction i.e. allergy to amoxicillin = upset stomach, nausea/diarrhea or allergy to kiwi = throat and lips swell, etc. The type of reaction to the food, medicine, allergen or health condition is very important. If you need to have a doctor send information to us, please let us know. Also, if your child has any type of asthma, mild or severe, and has a prescription for an inhaler, you will need to fill out the medication forms.

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If your child has strep throat or another bacterial infection, he/she should stay home until the antibiotic has been given for at least 24 hours and your health care provider has given permission for your child to return to school. We encourage you to seek medical attention when your child is sick and to follow your health care provider's recommendations about returning to school and other activities.

What is a KINGS Ticket?

Students are encouraged to receive individual or class KINGS tickets each week by following our KINGS Expectations. In and around each area of the elementary building students are taught how they can **K**eept safe, show **I**m responsible, **N**ever give up, use **G**ood manners and **S**how respect throughout the day. Students who display these skills may receive a KINGS ticket from their classroom teacher or another staff member, which can be placed in a weekly drawing. On Fridays, two winners from each grade level are chosen out of all the KINGS tickets turned in that week. These weekly winners receive a bag of popcorn that was popped by our wonderful volunteers! The remaining tickets are put in a big, grade specific, bucket for our monthly drawing. The monthly drawing chooses 10 students from each grade level and rewards them for their positive behavior with a variety of treats over the year from doughnuts to school supplies and/or other donated items.
