(all students/staff are included)

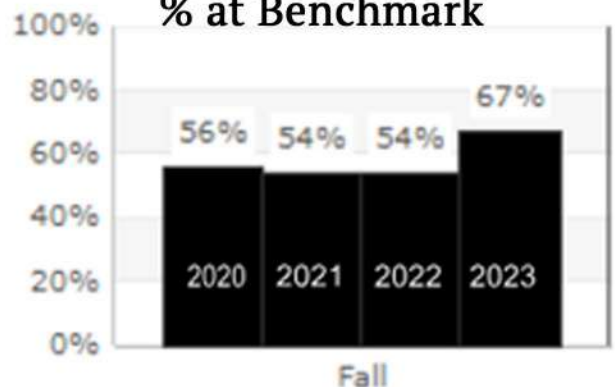

Students and teachers spend approximately 25 minutes in KINGS CASTLE each early release week where we focus on a specific topic or activity to introduce the strategies mentioned above.

KINGS Tickets

Students can earn KINGS tickets throughout the year.

Teachers and staff award students with a KINGS ticket as they see them following expectations.

At the end of each week these tickets go into grade level bins and 2 names are picked to win a bag of popcorn. An entire class may also be picked to receive popcorn due to a staff person witnessing the whole class following an expectation. Individual KINGS tickets that are not picked for popcorn that week go into a larger grade level bucket to be eligible for the monthly drawing. At the end of each month 5 tickets from each grade level bucket are picked as winners of the monthly drawing. These students have received prizes such as cookies, donuts, sports drinks,

t-shirts, coloring/activity books, or an item of their choosing from a variety of donations.

I - I'm Responsible

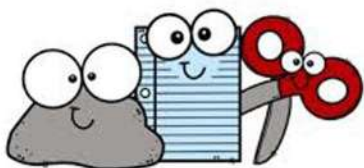
N - Never Give Up

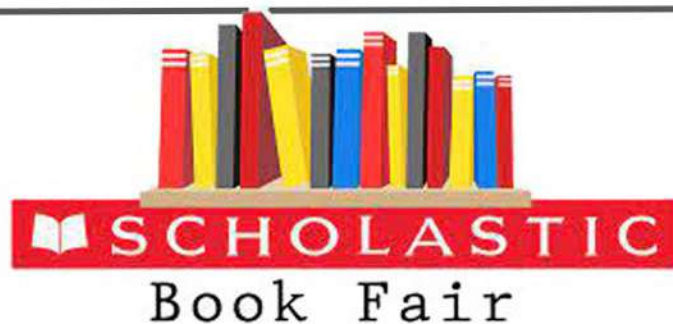

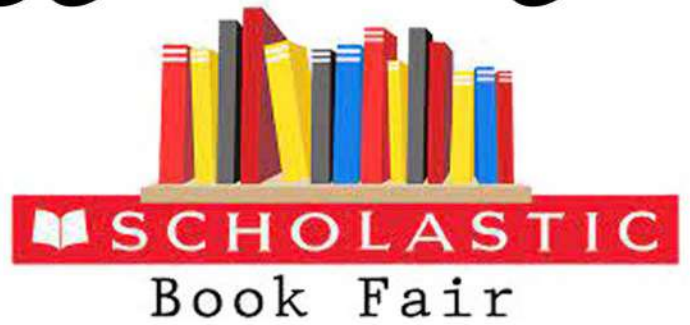
