MYSTERY SCIENCE ACTIVITY

The students in Mrs. Davidson's class were working on a Mystery Science Activity "Why do you need to clean a fish tank, but not a pond"? The



students learned about how decomposers (fungi and bacteria), producers (plants and animals), all live together in a balanced ecosystem. In order to keep the ecosystem balanced the carbon dioxide needs to be at a healthy level. Each living organism either adds or subtracts carbon dioxide from the pond. The students had to figure out how to keep the carbon dioxide at a safe level when adding producers, consumers, and decomposers to the pond.

ANNUAL WAKE UP AND READ BREAKFAST

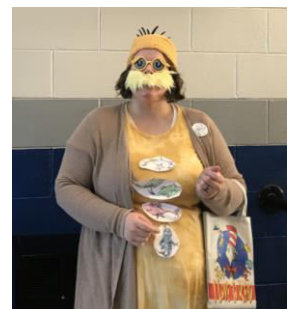
Thank you to everyone who participated in our Annual Wake Up and Reading Breakfast. We
