#### What Is Title I?

Title I is a federally funded program that provides funding to states and school districts to help meet the needs of educationally at-risk students. The goal of Title I is to provide extra instructional services beyond the regular classroom to students who are performing below grade level expectations and are most at risk of failing the state's challenging performance standards in mathematics, reading, and writing. Support is provided by

a Title I teacher or paraprofessional either individually, or in a small group. Students are selected for services based on specific assessments and teacher input.
