FOURTH GRADE PARTICIPATED IN MTU'S OUTDOOR SCIENCE FIELD TRIPS

All of the 4th grade classes participated in MTU's Outdoor Science Field trips this past week. Students investigated which type of insulator would work best in a cold environment. Groups of students were given a particular type of sock, either wool, cotton, fleece, terry cloth, or quilted to place over a water bottle filled with warm water. Students made a hypothesis about which type of sock would be the best insulator and recorded data such as temperature, precipitation, and learned what the terms 'variable' and 'control' meant. The students tested their hypothesis by venturing outdoors to take temperature measurements periodically while in a cold

measurements periodically w environment. Most classes found the wool sock to be the best insulator. All classes finished the experiment with a fun snowshoe around the school's rock garden searching for signs of animal tracks and burrows.
