However, this year we are just hanging out with

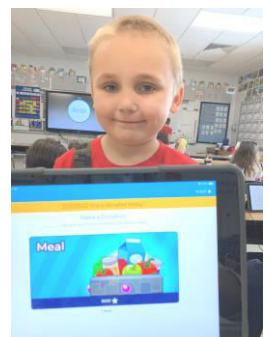
Humphrey during the day here at school. He even
